Five/six people will work both "4:30" and "6:30" seatings, and will eat during the 6:00-6:30 break: Mary Kanitz, Lynn Crawford, Marilyn Geiger, Betsy Abert, Bob Porth. (Marion M. will at least work 4:30 session, and will be available for the second session if we're short-handed.)

Rita will work the 'ticket sales' table. Judy Balistreri may also be able to help with this.

Tara W. and Chris Misovie will work at 4:30, eat at 6:30

Jan S. will work at 6:30, may eat at 4:30

Mike McCarthy will help out with the bar. Nancy Wucherer will run a cash box at the bar, but wants the initial free beers to be tracked with tickets from the "check-in/ticket sales" table

Student Volunteers:

We will have one NHS student from Cudahy HS who will start at 4PM. We will probably have 5 SMMS students (all in string orchestra program) who will help out from around 5:30 to around 6:30 - the goal is to have them clean tables, etc. We should set aside food for these student volunteers.

Even though we've heard nothing from SMHS via normal channels, Carol Rehak may be able to get us some NHS students from SMHS. If so, I've asked that the students plan to work from 4 to 7 pm, or from 6 to 9 pm.

## Assigned Tasks:

Don:

- 1) Goes to Restaurant Depot on Saturday morning, gets "butter pats" (one box of around 250), plastic serving gloves, and around 1/2 gallon (or more) of grated horseradish
- 2) Will bring "tickets" of menu items to help coordinate servers with kitchen staff
- 3) Brings a roll of blank tickets for use as "beverage" tickets
- 4) Brings a folding table to help augment seating in Clubhouse
- 5) Brings a large coffee percolator (w/ basket), in case the Clubhouse percolators are NG
- 6) Brings a kitchen scale

Tara:

Will bring salt and pepper shakers

Jody:

- 1) Preps the yard signs for proper starting times, gets them out where they can be seen.

Betsy:

- 1) Has ordered bread, will pick up
- 2) Will pick up the beer at 11:00 AM Saturday, will get help from Bob Porth in putting the beer into a cooler at around 12:15 pm.
- 3) Will bring coffee? (Altera?)

Marilyn:

- 1) Gets pretzles, beer cups
- 2) Will print up menus for this year
- 3) Will bring cups, bowls, plastic tableware, tea bags from her home stash
- 4) Will pick up the food on Sunday. (Reminder - ask to have a couple of trays weighed)
- 5) Will bring the ice bags, cakes from Piggly Wiggly
- 6) Brings shamrocks, votive candles, etc.
